## Privacy Policy

### 1. Who We Are

Painters in Pubs is an event series organized in London that brings together tradespeople and the public for talks and networking. For the purposes of UK data protection law, the data controller is:

### 2. What Personal Data We Collect

When you register for a Painters in Pubs event through our landing page, we collect the following information:

- **Name** — to identify your registration
- **Email address** — to send you event confirmation and updates
- **Any other information you voluntarily provide** in the registration

We do not collect sensitive personal data such as financial details, health information, or identity documents.

### 3. How We Use Your Data

We use your personal data for the following purposes:

- **Event administration** — confirming your registration, sending event details, and managing attendance
- **Communication** — contacting you about changes, cancellations, or important updates to the event you have registered for
- **Future event notifications** — only with your explicit consent, informing you about upcoming Painters in Pubs events

We will only use your data for purposes you have consented to, or where we have a legitimate interest in doing so (such as administering the event you have signed up for).

### 4. Legal Basis for Processing

Under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), we rely on the following lawful bases:

- **Contract performance** — processing your registration data is necessary to fulfil our obligation to provide you with event access
- **Legitimate interests** — sending essential event communications such as cancellations or venue changes
- **Consent** — where we ask your permission to contact you about future events. You may withdraw your consent at any time.

## 5. How We Store Your Data

Registration data submitted through our landing page is processed using Google Forms / Google Apps Script and stored in Google Sheets, operated by Google LLC. Google's data processing is covered by their own privacy and data protection terms.

We take reasonable steps to protect your information and limit access to authorized organizers only.

## 6. How Long We Keep Your Data

We retain your registration data for the following periods:

- **Event registrations** — deleted within 90 days of the event taking place
- **Marketing consent records** — deleted within 90 days of the event taking place

After these periods, your data will be securely deleted.

## 7. Sharing Your Data

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal data. We may share your data in the following limited circumstances:

- **Event venue** — we may share a guest list (names only) with the venue for entry management purposes
- **Google LLC** — as the provider of our registration and data storage infrastructure
- **Legal requirements** — if required to do so by law or a regulatory authority

We do not transfer your data outside the UK or EEA except where Google's infrastructure is involved, which is covered by appropriate Standard Contractual Clauses.

## 8. Your Rights

Under UK GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- **Right of access** — you can request a copy of the personal data we hold about you
- **Right to rectification** — you can ask us to correct inaccurate data
- **Right to erasure** — you can ask us to delete your data ('right to be forgotten')
- **Right to restrict processing** — you can ask us to limit how we use your data
- **Right to data portability** — you can ask for your data in a portable format
- **Right to object** — you can object to processing based on legitimate interests
- **Right to withdraw consent** — if processing is based on consent, you may withdraw it at any time
